

EM&V Forum Purpose

Assist participating states to implement demandside resource policies and programs to meet energy, environmental and economic goals through the *development and use of common or consistent EM&V protocols* in the Northeast and Mid-Atlantic region to estimate, track and report:

- Energy and demand savings
- Related costs
- Related air emission impacts







Forum Value Proposition

- Increase the reliability and credibility of demand-side resources in meeting energy and environmental goals
- Reduce costs of demand-side resource evaluation and research
- Increase participation in demand-side resource markets
- Improve state, regional and local demand-side resource planning, implementation and evaluation
- Inform the likely development of national/international standards and protocols in near-term and long-term

- Manage project contractors

Third Party Contractors

- Advise protocol development
- Conduct coordinated research and evaluation;
- Develop and maintain forum website
- Develop and maintain on-line database for common protocols

Steering Committee:

- State representation RGGI states + DC?
- High level commissioners or senior staff
- PUCs and air regulators (NESCAUM)

Project Committees:

- PUC and air regulatory staff, PAs, merchant providers, ISO/RTO staff
- Subcommittees within each Project Committee to lead projects
- Recommend protocols for Steering Committee adoption
